

## How do I add multiple devices to one number?

Combine a user's fixed-line device with a mobile, softphone or other device. To do this, click on the "User's" tab within Smart PBX. Go to the specific user and click on "Devices." You will then be able to add another device and tie it to the user. You will then also be able to choose a phone number for the device - it can be the same number as the other devices.

In this example the customer has one ATA device assigned you can select from the pull-down SIP, Cell Phone, Smartphone, Soft Phone, Landline, Fax, ATA, or SIP URI.
